AWARD DESCRIPTION AND CRITERIA

The Mike and Phoebe Award is the highest citation and honor given on behalf of the descendants of Mike and Phoebe at its bi-annual family reunion. The award reflects the family values, spiritual vitality and indefatigable commitment of our forbearers in furthering the nobility of our magnificent African-American heritage. The recipients of this award will be judged on the basis of their standing and record in the following categories:

1. Community Involvement in program and services that are involved in enhancing the economic, spiritual, political, and social lives of African-American families and individuals.
2. Ability to use education, training, and/or overall expertise to upgrade the functioning and overall achievements of individuals and groups.
3. Support the family reunion. The biannual DOMAP reunion has become an institution. The reunion is the primary event and vehicle in assuring that the family remains cohesive and committed to the legacy of our ancestors.
4. Engage in works that reflect the attitude, spirit, and philosophy of Mike and Phoebe, who refused to allow the horrendous acts of slavery to destroy the family.
5. Provide extensive and compassionate family care for the indigent.
6. Receive high acclaim as a professional/expert in one's chosen area endeavor.
